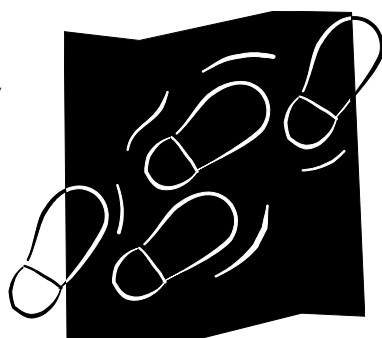

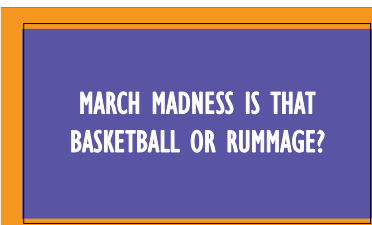

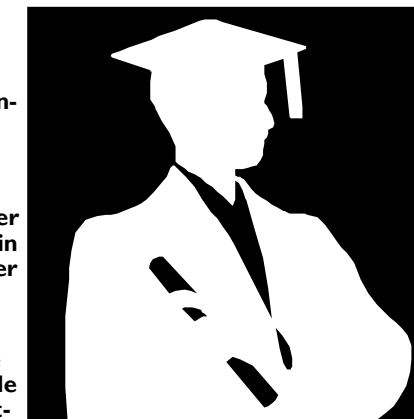
Wednesday Nights:
