

We have partnered with Planning Center Online to bring you the Church Center App. This app will allow you to check into worship, register for events, and give electronically, just to name a few features.

Giving Online

We had original-planned to roll out a new giving platform in early April, but due to the current health situation, we have decided to move up our timeline. We are excited to partner with Planning Center Giving as our new electronic giving platform. We have been using Planning Center in several of our ministries over the years and have almost completely moved our entire church management into Planning Center.

You can sign up by clicking the **GIVE** button on the homepage of our website, or by downloading the Church Center app on your Apple or Android device.

If you're already giving electronically and can't switch right away, don't worry, we'll be moving over to the new system slowly. We'll update you with a deadline to switch in the coming week. You can also drop off your offering, notes to the staff, etc. in the secure, locked dropbox by entrance #4 (Common Cup).
