

CUMC Updates

- We are offering an 8:30am Traditional Service on the Square, a 9:30am Traditional Service in the Poplar Sanctuary, and an 11am Modern Service in the Foundry. We will continue to have a streaming service at 10:45am every Sunday.
- We encourage you to download the Church Center App in your app store in order to virtually "register" for which of our four services you'll attend. This is not a requirement to attend, it's just a tool for us to use in order to be prepared!
- We will currently only reopen for in person



worship. Other ministries will continue to be online, including Sunday School and weekday programming. Childcare will not be available at this time.

- We encourage you to follow these guidelines when planning to attend service:

- Take temperature readings of who are planning on attending service. If you or others in your household are running a temperature, please stay home.
- Observe social distancing from pew to parking lot and back.
- Wear a personal mask covering your mouth and nose in order to protect others and yourself from airborne particles. We will have masks available should you need one.


Procedures During an Outbreak or Pandemic
