## CUMC Updates

- We are offering an 8:30am Traditional Service on the Square, a 9:30am Traditional Service in the Poplar Sanctuary, and an 11am Modern Service in the Foundry. We will continue to have a streaming service at 10:45am every Sunday.
- We encourage you to download the Church Center App in your app store in order to virtually "register" for which of our four services you'll attend. This is not a requirement to attend, it's just a tool for us to use in order to be prepared!
- We will currently only reopen for in person worship. Other ministries will continue to be online, including Sunday School and weekday programming. Childcare will not be available at this time.
- We encourage you to follow these guidelines when planning to attend service:

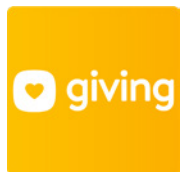
- Take temperature readings of who are planning on attending service. If you or others in your household are running a temperature, please stay home.
- Observe social distancing from pew to parking lot and back.
- Wear a personal mask covering your mouth and nose in order to protect others and yourself from airborne particles. We will have masks available should you need one.

## Procedures During an Outbreak or Pandemic

In February with the threat of COVID-19 looming, the staff began writing an official "Response Plan" for how we might go about slowing down ministries in order to remain more safe. Little did we know that by mid-March the government would declare "Safer at Home" with all in-person ministries coming to a halt. We knew it would not last forever, and so the staff, with the help of our Leader Council, then began writing our plan on how to reopen in steps as we understand how to live in this season with a pandemic.
