Job Description

Overview / Purpose

Coordinate ministry and program offerings for older adults to address the needs, concerns, and issues in our congregation and community. Design ministry by, with, and for older adults. Advocate on behalf of older adult and aging concerns.

Overview:

Show a genuine interest in helping older adults deepen their relationship with God and God's people. This leader should be skilled in researching, planning, and implementing ministry with older adults. This person needs to work well with others – individually and in groups. Promote the vision and mission of CUMC. Finally, there should be evidence of active and growing Christian discipleship.

- Communicate with the staff liaison to be sure that goals are being attained
- Update social media and communications with staff liaison
- Collaborate with the Adults & Small Groups Coordinators and staff liaison to build and implement a system of small groups for older adults to grow and develop as disciples of Jesus Christ
- Advocate inclusion of older adults in all aspects of the ministry of the congregation
- Work with others to plan and carry out a varied and wide-ranging program with older adults which includes worship, discipleship, missions, evangelism and fellowship
- Be familiar with curriculum resources in order to make recommendations for classes and groups for older adults.
- Recruit teachers and leaders
- Advise of any accessibility issues
