Job Description

Overview / Purpose

The responsibilities of the Witness Task Team include the development of programs and events that will educate the congregation in the areas of creating a Spirit of Invitation as well as Faith Sharing/Evangelism. This in turn promotes the church's vision and mission.

Committee Responsibilities:

- Educate and implement programs to help Collierville UMC members learn to share their faith with their F.R.A.N.s (Friends, Relatives, Associates, and Neighbors)
- Encourage the Collierville UMC Family to invite people without a church
- Find ways to begin teaching our congregation how to share our faith stories.
- In conjunction with the Community Connection Task Team develop neighborhood saturation events, including neighborhood canvassing

Chairperson

Overview:

This leader must have passion for telling all people by word and action the good news of God's love through Jesus Christ. This leader must also have a passion for teaching those in our congregation how to invite their F.R.A.N.'s to worship or an event, as well as sharing our faith stories. This leader must listen and communicate well with people of all ages, care deeply that people know Christ, be able to work with church members, visitors, and unchurched people. This person must explore new 21st century ways of reaching people.

- Maintain a healthy and growing spiritual life and lead others to do the same
- Elect a Vice-Chair and a secretary to record minutes at the first meeting of the year
- Communicate with your staff liaison to discuss the agenda for the meetings

Coordinate

- Develop evangelism programs, such as "*Servant Evangelism*", for example:
 - "Candy Canes for Collierville" @ Tree Lighting Event on the Square
 - "Balloons" @ May Event on Square promoting VBS, Winshape & Youth Mins
 - Experiences around the Summer Music on the Square, etc.
- Work with the Hospitality Work Area to reach out to those using our facilities for events, i.e., Baccalaureate, Chamber Music Series, AA, Basketball teams, etc.
- Develop neighborhood saturation events, including neighborhood canvassing
