Overview:

This leader exemplifies generous living, is devoted to life-long learning and is passionate about helping others learn and grow in knowledge and faith. This ministry leader needs a strong understanding of biblical stewardship and management of all that God gives and provides. Useful skills for this position are the ability to listen to and communicate with people of all ages; interest in a wide range of stewardship experiences; ability to work with others involved in all aspects of Christian stewardship; aptitude for researching issues; and ability to develop, organize, and implement stewardship programs and events.

- Elect a Vice-Chair and a secretary to record minutes at the first meeting of the year
- Communicate with your staff liaison to discuss the agenda for the meetings
- Updating social media
- Encourage daily stewardship (discipleship) efforts
- Direct the campaign effort toward the annual pledging of funds needed to maintain the programs needed for the church's efforts both locally and around the world
- Support and encourage the staff and pastors in their individual efforts of teaching/preaching stewardship weekly
- Coordinate with others the planning and implementation of a comprehensive, year round plan for Christian stewardship that includes education, inspiration, and volunteer action
- Encourage the congregation to live daily with stewardship in their lives through their prayers, presence, gifts, service and witness as disciples of Jesus Christ.
- Work closely with finance leaders to grow a culture of generosity among the church family and challenging the congregation to be generous in funding the ministry of the church. To develop a wider view of stewardship of all the resources God has given.
- Be familiar with United Methodist and other stewardship resources and facilitate their use by all age levels and faith stages
- Lead the celebration of Christian stewardship in worship and fellowship opportunities throughout the year. Topics might include mission and connectional giving, living more frugally, personal financial planning, and care of the planet
