It was reported that the government loan may be forgiven if all the rules have been followed. Don Hannigan will be working with the bank. They will make sure to walk us through the application for approval for the forgiveness of the loan.

Our reserves now have moved up to 140,000.

Our proposed budget was unanimously approved.

Don Hannigan reported that we would be applying for the Government PP loan for the 2021 year. We will go through rules to see if we qualify.

Bob thanked the staff for their role in balancing the budget and they deserve to be given a lot of credit in its preparation.

We have received letters of resignation from Jennifer Ricks who has been our Child Care Coordinator. She has recently had a new baby and has decided to be a stay at home mom. Replacement will possibly be part time person along with current staff to help staff Nurseries as needed.

We also received a letter from Michael Aneneus, who has been our Sound Tech, who will be following his heart to begin a new life in Jackson, TN. Eric Evans, who has been shadowing Michael, will become our new Technical Director.

Trustees – John McCarty – Property donated by Mary Louise Cox has been sold. 45 Acres on Farley sold and we received \$82,134.77.

The 126 acres in Desoto county were sold. One parcel of 66 acres we were 50% owners and the other parcel we were 1 of 6 owners. We received 105,524 in this sell.

Discussion at next Trustee's meeting will be on how the church can honor Mary Louise Cox for this gift she willed to the church

Nominations are still being processed by Rev. Deborah Suddarth and Beverly Crossnoe to finish filling in the vacant positions on the board.
