Jeannie Jones questioned the terminology of the All in Fund. She was under the impression that it was not to be a debt reduction plan. She thought that it for the paying off of our buildings.

Don Gary, Financial Chairman, tried to explain that we were extending the All in program for one more year instead of having financial campaign. Finance is planning to meet to decide what to do with the

10% that had been set aside. We received \$206,000 from the government that we do not have to repay however we do not qualify for a second payment from the government because we have to be 25% below our budget goal. We have been continuing to give so we have not been below 11% of our budget.

Ron Lip asked how the Government money was being used and J.D. Peebles ask if the endowment would get their 10% from these fund. Jessica Nichol tried to clarify the use of the funds in the paying toward our bills and total debt.

Don Continued to give his total report which is in an attachment.

Finance will be sending out a letter concerning debt reduction and with concerns to be able to make our notes. Copy of letter was read. Administrative Board was asked to vote on approval of the letter to be sent. All but one voted to send the letter. (copy of letter attached)

Bob Vornbrock- SPRC Chairman- We will be having called meetings with Bishop McAlly and Rev. Dr. Debra Smith to discuss where we will go from here to replace our Senior Pastor. We are feeling God working among us as we reflect on the ministry of Rev. David Atkinson. We are grieving in his passing and we are in no hurry in terms of replacing him as Senior Pastor. Dr. Harry Durbin will stay with us until Sept. and possibly longer.

In early June discussions will start as to how to proceed and handle the transition. SPRC is the voice of the congregation.

We are looking for a Modern Worship leader, SNAP Director and a Part-Time Nursery Director

Rev. Dr. Deborah Suddarth-Pastor's Report- Started with great emotion her report acknowledging those who had been faithful in their attendance and that would be greatly missed Bill Bice and Rev. Atkinson.

That it was strange to give this report. As David would have said as our spiritual leader "Be at Peace, it is what it is"

I ask that you continue to lift up our staff and encourage them. We appreciate Dr. Harry Durbin in the peace he brings to heal us in our grief. Dr. Durbin , Rev. Tondala, and myself will be intentional in our plans through July to work to heal our church. We have new hope and new life to bring comfort to our church.

With our grief addressed we continue to address to Covid policies. We can now be mask free in worship but she will continue to wear a mask for a while in support of those who do not yet feel comfortable going without.
